Super User

The highest designation granted by ATF to an external eForms user. Super Users can perform the following actions:

- Submit Forms
- View all forms submitted for FFLs (delegates and submitters)
- Approve/reject association requests by delegates and submitters
- Revoke delegates and submitter associations from FFLs/AECA
- There can only be one super user per FFL/AECA



Delegate

A Delegate can perform the following actions:

- Submit forms
- View all forms submitted for FFLs/AECA
- Approve/reject association requests by Submitters
- Revoke Submitters from FFLs/AECA
- Complete a 6a for a Form 6 that was completed by a Submitter of Super User



Submitter

• Submit forms on behalf of associated FFLs/AECA's, as well as forms that do not require FFL numbers.

Note: If you have the role of Submitter, you should only have access to forms that you have submitted



COMMON PITFALLS

- Know the manufacturer
- Don't select models that are "close" in the dropdown (eForms).
- If you're unsure about the make and model of a firearm, do some research first. (incomplete submissions can delay processing times because ATF must have complete information)
- When in doubt, always provide clear photos that show all markings on the firearm.



COMMON PITFALLS

- Most modern firearms have a model designation.
- If it's an older rifle or shotgun with no visible model, you can put the type as the model (i.e., bolt action, SxS, O/U). Provide photos as proof!
- Be sure to list the model on the Form 6 application as it's marked on the gun.



Current Processing Times

- Average Form 6 turnaround= around two weeks
- Eforms vs. paper Form 6's
 (Eform 6's are processed 5 days quicker on average)
- Official processing time is still 4 to 6 weeks
 (Always plan for the official processing time)



FUTURE EFORM ENHANCEMENT ON HOLD

• Ability to upload serial number attachment (i.e., excel spreadsheet) for F6's/6A submissions when serial numbers are numerous and nonconsecutive.
