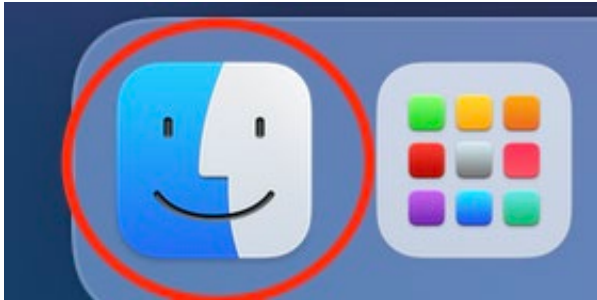
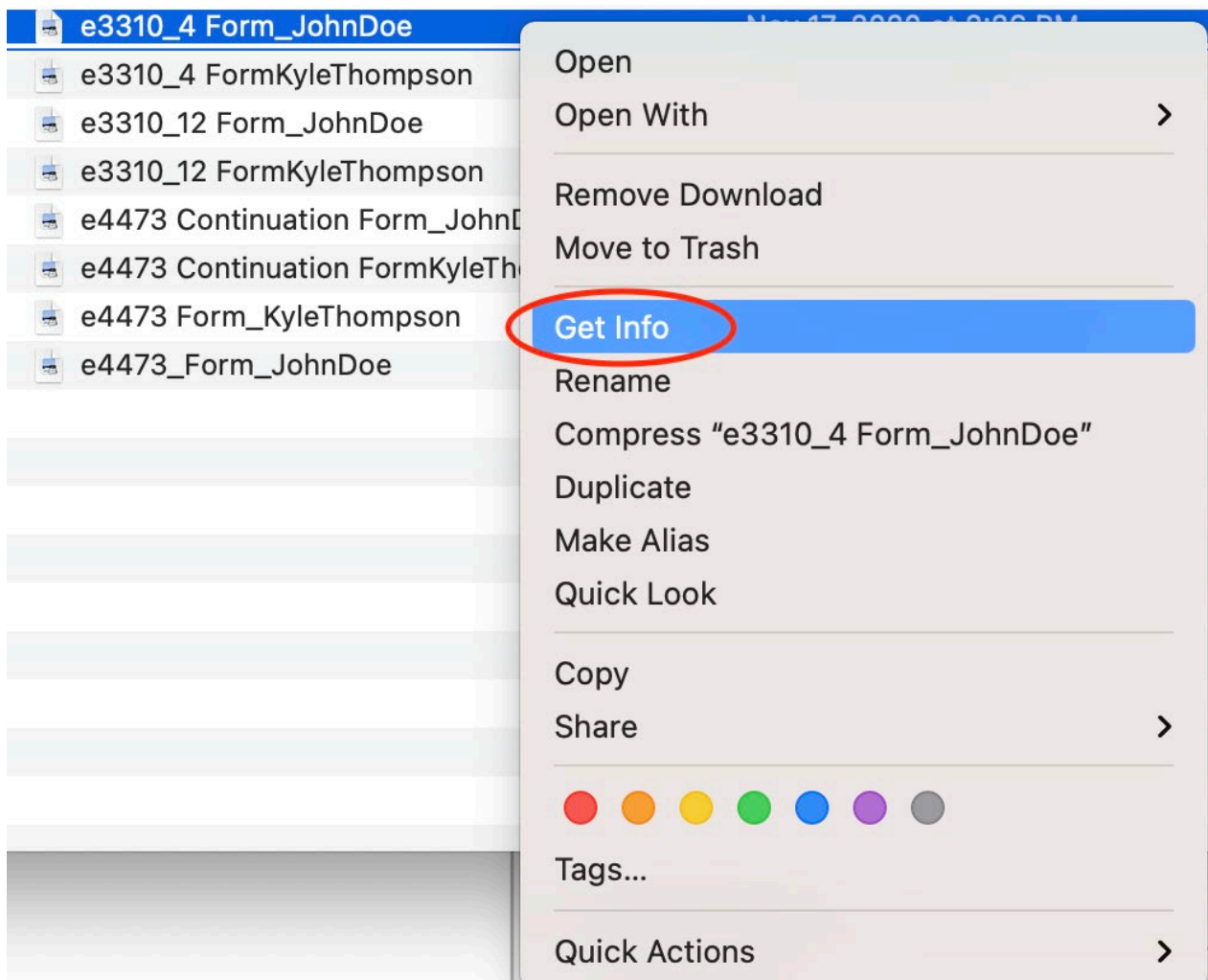


## Changing Default Reader to Google Chrome


On the Mac dock, at the bottom of the screen, select and open the *Finder* application.



In Finder, right-click on any PDF file and choose "**Get Info**".



In the Open with section, select **“Google Chrome”** as the default PDF reader and click the **“Change All”** button.
